

Ranked one of the top colleges for veterans by the *U.S. News & World Report*, Georgetown University's School of Continuing Studies (SCS) proudly supports the Yellow Ribbon Program, enhancing financial access for student veterans. Only veterans entitled to the maximum benefit rate (based on service requirements on record with the Department of Veterans Affairs) or their designated transferees may receive this funding.

## ELIGIBILITY FOR VETERANS BENEFITS

### You may be eligible if you:

- Served an aggregated period of active duty of at least 36 months after September 10, 2001. Time spent satisfying the ROTC/Service Academy/Loan Repayment Program active duty obligation does not count toward the active duty service necessary to qualify for the benefits.
- Were honorably discharged from active duty for a service-connected disability and served 30 continuous days after September 10, 2001.
- Are a dependent eligible for Transfer of Entitlement under the Post-9/11 GI Bill based on a veteran's service under the eligibility criteria listed above.

## ELIGIBILITY FOR YELLOW RIBBON PROGRAM BENEFITS

- You must be eligible for the maximum benefit rate under the Post-9/11 GI Bill.
- You must not be on active duty or a spouse transferee of an active duty member.
- You must provide a Certificate of Eligibility Letter from the Department of Veterans Affairs stating your maximum Post-9/11 benefit and military service dates.
- Your school must not have offered Yellow Ribbon Program benefits to more than the maximum number of individuals stated in its participation agreement.
- Your school must certify your enrollment to Veterans Affairs, including Yellow Ribbon Program information.



The Post-9/11 GI Bill with Yellow Ribbon Program will **pay 100% of Georgetown SCS tuition** for undergraduate and graduate students in degree programs.\*

## FOR ACTIVE DUTY SERVICEMEMBERS

- Active duty servicemembers and their spouses are not eligible for the Post-9/11 GI Bill benefits.
- Child transferees of active duty servicemembers may be eligible if the servicemember is qualified at the 100% rate.
