

Veterans Benefits – Eligible Noncredit Programs

The following certificate programs are eligible for funding through the Department of Veterans Affairs under the Post-9/11 GI Bill (Chapter 33), Montgomery GI Bill (Chapter 30), Dependants' Educational Assistance - DEA (Chapter 35) and Vocational Rehabilitation (Chapter 31) programs. Only courses required for completion of the certificate can be certified to the VA, and only on-campus certificate programs are eligible for funding. Students using VA benefits cannot combine online & on-campus classes for a certificate.
